Research Grants For Clinical and Human Experimental Pain Research

- These bi-annual grants totalling up to € 200,000 from Grünenthal GmbH, Germany, are aimed at supporting young scientists in carrying out innovative and exploratory clinical pain research projects in any EFIC chapter country (see www.EFIC.org).
- The decision on the awarding of grants is made entirely by the EFIC Sub-Committee on Research.
- Research grants are intended for clinical and human experimental research projects on the subject of pain. Research proposals on animals, computer simulations etc will not be considered.
- Research grants are valued at up to € 30,000 per project. The duration of projects should not be longer than two years.
